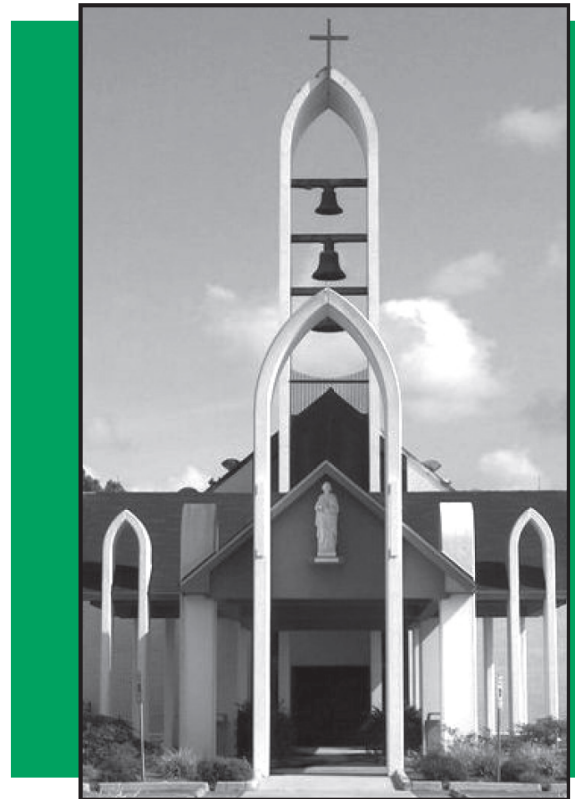

- To be determined.

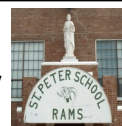

Dear Parishioners,

There is a 'break' from the usual Sundays in Ordinary Time today. August 6<sup>th</sup> is the Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord. It is a major feast, so when it falls on a Sunday, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Transfiguration. In Scripture's symbolic language, mountains aren't just places; they are experiences that put us closer to God. The Apostles, Peter, James, and John had a unique experience on top of the mountain; they experienced Jesus being *transfigured before their eyes*. Transfiguration promises that within our ordinary lives is the *life-changing* presence of God, if only we listen for it.
