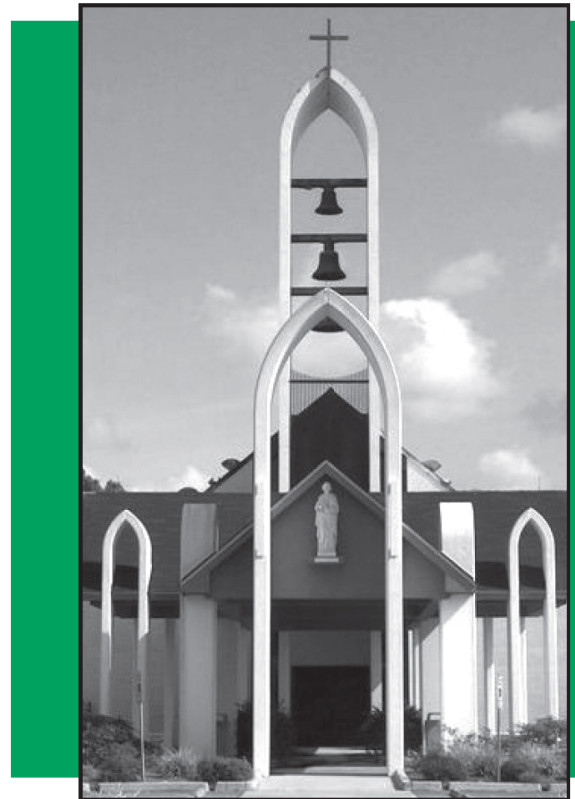

Our confidence in His promise assures us that Jesus is here with us now as we celebrate the Eucharist—the Mass.
