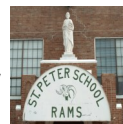

Dear Parishioners,

Today we begin the season of Advent, which marks the start of a new liturgical year for the Church. The readings for Sunday Mass are arranged on a three-year cycle. Each year features a different Gospel—Matthew, Mark, or Luke.



Readings from the Gospel of John are interspersed throughout all three years. With this year's first Sunday of Advent, we begin Cycle B of the Lectionary, which focuses our attention on the Gospel of Mark. This week and next week, our readings from Mark's Gospel present two important Advent themes: the Lord's return at the end of time and John the Baptist's preparation for Jesus. Today's Gospel reminds us that Advent is about more than our preparation for the Church's celebration of Christ's birth at Christmas. Advent is also about preparing ourselves for Christ's return in glory at the end of time. Like the disciples and the faithful in Mark's community, we must also stay alert and watchful. Our faithfulness to God, through the good times as well as the difficult times, shows us to be ready for the coming of the Son of Man.

**The second collection this weekend is for the Building Maintenance Fund.**

The monthly **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** will be on **Wednesday, December 6<sup>th</sup>**. Adoration begins at 1:00 P.M. and concludes with Benediction at 6:00 P.M. I encourage and invite you to spend some time in quiet prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. What a perfect way to prepare ourselves for Christmas, as to spend some time with our Eucharistic Lord.

On December 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> will be the annual **Retirement Fund for Religious**. Your gift will provide essential care for nearly 25,000 senior sisters, brothers, and religious order priests who have dedicated their lives to serving others.

## **Liturgical Celebration of the 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas Vigil-**

This year, December 24, 2023, is on the 4th Sunday of Advent. This has given rise to some questions regarding the liturgies for these consecutive celebrations. Please note that **all Masses celebrated before 4:00 PM on Sunday, December 24th are to use the prayers and readings for the 4th Sunday of Advent. All Masses celebrated after 4:00 PM on Sunday, December 24th are to use the prayers and readings for Christmas. In order to celebrate appropriately, a person should participate in Masses for the 4th Sunday of Advent and again for Christmas Vigil/Day.** In the Liturgy of the Hours, on Sunday, December 24, 2017, Morning Prayer; Daytime Prayer; and the Office of Readings for the 4th Sunday of Advent should be used. Evening Prayer I of Christmas and Night Prayer I should be prayed on the evening of Sunday, December 24th. If you have any questions regarding this, please call the Office of Worship at 504-861-6300 or email [worship@arch-no.org](mailto:worship@arch-no.org).

## **Liturgical Considerations for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (New Year's Day)-**

Because January 1, 2024, falls on a Monday, **the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God is not observed as a day of obligation although it remains a Solemnity.** Because Sunday is always a day of obligation, precedence would be given to the celebration of Sunday Mass. Therefore, **all Masses, including evening Masses, celebrated on December 31, 2023, are to be that of the Feast of the Holy Family.** Likewise, on Sunday, December 31, 2017, the hours for the Feast of the Holy Family should be used when praying the Liturgy of the Hours.
