

2024 St. Peter School Alumni of the Year: Joel R. Ocmand Sr.

A 1971 graduate of St. Peter School, Mr. Joel R. Ocmand Sr. has spent his lifetime serving as a prime example of the value of a Catholic education and allegiance to one's alma mater. A retiree from Shell Oil Co., he served as the United States lead for the Shell Oil Company Operator Surveillance Electronic Monitoring Systems. Now, Mr. Ocmand takes pride in serving as the President of St. John ARC Board of Directors and St. Peter Parish's Pastoral Council Lead. His efforts to serve his community, however, are not just recent. Rather, they span his entire lifetime.

During his youth, Mr. Ocmand served as the Columbian Squires Chief, before completing his education at Delgado College. Since then, he has gone on to serve our local community through various groups. As a part of the KC Council 2436 in Reserve, Mr. Ocmand served as Grand Knight from 1988 to 1990, winning the Louisiana Top 5 Council, Star Council award. He also was the recipient of Knight of the Year and Family of the Year several times and now serves as the current Council CYLA Chairman, Food for Families Director, and Financial Secretary, a position which has held for the last 15 years.

Mr. Ocmand's work with the Louisiana Knights of Columbus is equally extensive. He won the State Deputy Award for Excellence 2018-2020. Past roles held include District Deputy River Parishes, where he directed several councils in our local parishes, and Past Louisiana State Youth Director, a position in which he oversaw all the K.C. State Youth programs throughout the year. He also served previously on the K.C. Convention Committee, as State CYLA Chairman, State Membership Director, State Supreme KC Eucharistic Congress Chairman, Fr. McGivney Guild Chairman, and State Promotions Chairman. Through these positions, he oversaw various programs that promoted the K.C. Organization. He is also the past and current Youth Expansion Program Chairman. In this role, Mr. Ocmand is in charge of fundraising efforts to support the youth programs of the State Knights of Columbus which includes, but is not limited to, scholarships, seminarian support, scouting, retreats, free throw contests, "Keep Christ in Christmas" poster contest, and college campus support.

Through his work as a part of the Archbishop Blenk Assembly 318, he was a past Faithful Comptroller, Navigator, Admiral, and Trustee. Now, he is the current Patriotic Chairman, awarding graduating seniors in the Tri-Parish Area. Through the assembly, Mr. Ocmand was awarded 4th Degree Family of the Year and 4th Degree Sir Knight of the Year.

Mr. Ocmand's efforts remained rooted here, though, in St. Peter Church and School. He was a eucharistic minister and oversaw the altar servers and their training for 10 years. In addition, he took on roles teaching high school Confirmation, working with St. Peter School's adult to student reading program, and leading St. Peter School's Kindergarten Science Experiment monthly program.

Mr. Ocmand credits these acts of service, achievements, and leadership positions to his Catholic Education. He believes they are all built upon a Catholic education which serves during the early education years to lay the foundation of our faith. It is this same foundation that he has spent his life working to help lay for others. That is why now I ask you to join me in congratulating our 2024 St. Peter School Alumni of the Year: Joel R. Ocmand Sr.


