



Dear Parishioners,

As we enter the Fifth Week of Easter, the Gospels will be taken from the 15th, 16th, and 17th chapters of St. John's Gospel. We will hear sections from these three chapters until the Solemnity of Pentecost. Today's passage



recalls the wisdom Jesus shared during the Last Supper. The Son of God uses images from creation to break open His hopes for how the disciples are to be in relationship with one another and with God. Today, He tells us, "I am the vine, and my Father is the vine grower." Their followers, then, and now, are the branches.


