



This week we return to the liturgical season of **Ordinary Time.** However, this Sunday and next Sunday are designated as solemnities—special days that call our attention to the central



mysteries of our Faith. Today, on the **THREE IN ONE** first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.** This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed Himself to us in the Trinity—one God in three Persons.


