

Dear Parishioners,

Three months have now elapsed since "switching gears" this past July 1<sup>st</sup>. We all deal with change differently since we are all unique people, created that way by God.



And yet, as people of faith, we are followers of Jesus, who, when He walked the earth, was a real agent of change to His fellow Jews and to non-Jewish people as well. To say that Jesus was an agent of change is an understatement, and all we need do is read the Gospels to see this. Jesus' call to change, was and is, only for our good and well-being as His followers. Jesus calls and challenges people to adapt and change in their individual and communal "comfort zones," and it isn't just a suggestion from Him – it is a necessary challenge that we are called to embrace and accept, but certainly not without adjustment and the allowance of time to help us with our adaptation to His call to discipleship as we journey in our Catholic faith. Almost a year ago, the news of parish merges in the Archdiocese of New Orleans was published and made known to all, and St. Peter and St. Hubert parishes have had to comply and adapt accordingly, with our fellow parishioners in several other parishes having to do the same. This is not easy for us, the archbishop has not said it is easy, nor does Jesus expect us to just "jump for joy" at this time of change, but we have to be realistic and honest about what the changes in the demographics and the economy in our archdiocese have brought about. We Catholics, of all people, should realize that coming together as a worshipping community is key, and not just wanting and staying in our spiritual comfort zones because it's convenient, safe, and familiar. We have been called to come together as brothers and sisters in Christ, bound together by our status as baptized Catholics, first and foremost. We now are called to literally merge and join together in a new way for our spiritual growth.





# Twenty-seventh Sunday FAITHFUL DISCIPLE in Ordinary Time

Gn 2:18-24 | Heb 2:9-11 | Mk 10:2-16

# GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Everything in God's creation is intended to reflect his goodness and proclaim his glory. It's not hard to understand this idea when we behold the majesty of the sea. It can be more difficult, however, to remember this is also present in each of us and in our relationships - including that relationship God designed for man and woman: marriage. Our ability to turn away from God means that we sometimes reject, rather than reflect, him. This is one reason why Jesus responds to the Pharisees' question by revoking Moses' allowance for divorce, a concession God had made to the Israelites in the Old Testament. Jesus' statement might be unsettling because, in our time, divorce has affected nearly everyone in one way or another. But his words indicate the strength of the covenant the Lord has made with us: his love is permanent and unbreakable. We learn that the unbreakable bond between spouses reflects, in an imperfect way, God's perfectly faithful love for us.

# GO EVANGELIZE

# PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

We find this truth about love in the wisdom of the Church. Love is not a "feeling." It is an action - a virtue - in which we consistently will the good of another. After all, this is who and what God is: a continuous outpouring of love. Our triune God is a relational community of love, and Jesus offers us the preeminent example of this: As the Son and out of love for the Father, he chose to remain on the cross, regardless of how he felt. Such was his love for us that he willed our redemption and sent us the Spirit to help us remain with him. Marriage, designed by God to mirror this triune communal, covenantal love, likewise requires a decision to love that is firm and constant, despite how we might feel. If we wish to be capable of the fidelity required for marriage, family life, or simply for our relationship with God, we must make the deliberate choice to love - and we must do it over and over. With time and with God's grace, the habit of choosing another's good becomes easier, and we experience the joy of a stable and authentic love.

PRACTICE We can reflect God's faithful love by becoming faithful ourselves. Choose one or two ways to exercise fidelity in little things this week. Examples might be getting up at the same time every morning without hitting the "snooze" button; spending five extra minutes in prayer each day; or offering a prayer of thanksgiving to God every time you are tempted to check your phone unnecessarily.


