Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, the final day of the Christmas/Epiphany season for the new liturgical year of 2025. On Monday, January 13, we begin Ordinary Time, and the liturgical color is green – symbolizing growth, increase, new life, fidelity, renewal, and hope. Hope, as proclaimed by Pope Francis, is the theme of this Holy Year of 2025, and a fitting one for our world and especially our parish. This past liturgical year brought change to St. Peter's and St. Hubert's, yet with the growth, increase, new life, fidelity, renewal, and hope that Ordinary Time brings, we as a parish family continue the "re-forming" that our archdiocese is experiencing. In the next couple of months we will be seeing more "re-forming" of existing parishes as demographics and population change, but the hope that these changes will bring new growth, new life, and renewal to our local Church, the Archdiocese of New Orleans, can also bring us all renewed fidelity to Christ, who said that the gates of Hell shall not prevail against His Church that He has founded on the Rock of St. Peter and the Apostles. Most of us are always open to the changes that *we decide to make*, and yet are naturally sometimes not open to the changes that others make. Such is the case with us here in Garyville and Reserve, St. Hubert's and St. Peter's. We are just in the beginning of our "re-forming," and hopefully our fidelity to our Catholic faith has not been shattered or dying. We still have ample access to the Eucharist, the Mass, the Sacraments, and our respective communities, yet we have been asked to change, to adapt, to re-group, to join together – did not Jesus do all these things when He preached and taught so long ago? Jesus Himself went to His cousin John the Baptist for a baptism of repentance in the Jordan – did Jesus need it? Of course not, but by this action, He was showing that He was part of the change, the renewal, the growth that He was soon going to proclaim to all who would listen with open hearts. Let us do the same listening if we haven't already done so and immerse ourselves in the cleansing and healing waters that Jesus has invited us into in our "re-forming" process in our Catholic community. By our own individual Baptisms, we were called to growth, increase, new life, renewal, and these things are accomplished with change. Let us not fear change – it may do us good!

## The Baptism of the Lord

Is 42:1-4, 6-7 | Acts 10:34-38 | Lk 3:15-16, 21-22

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In many renditions of the Baptism of Jesus, artists connect the scene at the Jordan River with Jesus' death. A withered tree, for example, reminds us of the cross, or a mountain points to Mount Calvary. These connections show a real relationship between Jesus' baptism and his passion: his baptism marks the acceptance and beginning of his mission, which would ultimately lead to his crucifixion. For us, too, baptism is a decisive moment which destines us for – you guessed it – death! Not physical death (which will happen regardless), but a death to everything that is not of God. By making us part of God's family as his adopted children, our baptism summons us to “die” to our old life of sin and take on new life in Christ. This means turning away each day from sin so we can become increasingly fit to spend eternity with God. Like Jesus who rose both from the baptismal waters and from the tomb, we are meant, by our daily efforts to be faithful – to “rise” with him in the new life he won for us.

### GO EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

After Jesus is baptized, two important events occur immediately: the Holy Spirit descends upon him while God the Father proclaims his delight in his Son: “You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.” Here we see the profound meaning of our own baptism and its effects. In addition to cleansing us from the stain of original sin, baptism: 1) gives us the gift of the Holy Spirit; and 2) welcomes us into God's family as his adopted children. Armed with the Holy Spirit and the assurance of God's fatherly care, we are equipped to engage in the daily struggle of dying-and-rising in Christ. We can always call on the Holy Spirit for strength when we face temptations or difficult decisions. Likewise, when we are discouraged or we confront our own weaknesses, we can look to the Father for help. Recall the words which the Father spoke to Jesus, and which he says to us in our baptism (and he doesn't take them back!): *You are my beloved son. You are my beloved daughter. With you I am well pleased.*

### CELEBRATE

Find the date (or approximate date) of your baptism and the baptismal dates of your immediate family members. Make a list of the dates and spend time thanking God for his fatherly care for you. Then, when someone's baptismal anniversary comes around, make sure to celebrate!
