Dear Parishioners.

Have you ever realized something that has always been, that you've experienced all your life, and, suddenly, it's like a light bulb goes off in your brain? Well, that happened to me this past Monday



night as I began writing this article. From Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday is 40 days, and from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday is 50 days – a total of 90 days or three months. I have never thought of this timeline before in all my 38 years of priesthood and 64 years of life! So for three months out of the year, we as Catholics focus on and celebrate Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection, also known as the "Paschal or Easter Mystery." But that doesn't mean that for the remaining nine months of the year that we don't celebrate Christ's dying and rising, but the Lent/ Easter/Ascension/Pentecost season is a continuous three-month journey which we enter each year in early spring, and we bloom at Easter when nature is literally blooming as well. The season of Advent/Christmas/ Epiphany is only about a third of the 90 days that I've just mentioned, yet the importance of the five weeks of beginning on the First Sunday of Advent are quite important as well in our spiritual journey throughout the calendar year. Since Ash Wednesday and Easter are "movable feasts," unlike December 25th, sometimes Lent and Easter come upon us a little unexpectedly; however, our awareness of the great importance of Lent/Easter/Ascension/Pentecost is crucial to our lives as Catholic people no matter our age. We learn best by doing, and then by informing ourselves through reading, study, and interaction with our fellow Catholic brothers and sisters, especially in the celebration of the Sunday Mass. So much can be learned by consistent attendance and participation in this highest form of prayer that we can engage in. And why does the Church call us to be part of the Sunday celebration? Sunday is the day of the Resurrection – Alleluia!



The Resurrection of the Lord

Acts 10:34a, 37-43 | Col 3:1-4 | Jn 20:1-9

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

After years (and, for many of us, decades) of celebrating Easter, we may not be sensitive to the sheer peculiarity of the Resurrection accounts. But a close reading of today's Gospel prompts us to ask: If most of us were dreaming up the greatest event in history, wouldn't we have made it more exciting? A little fanfare would have gotten the message out to the world and nipped future skepticism in the bud. Yet this is not what God did. The account of Jesus' resurrection has no fanfare; in fact, it is not an account of a resurrection at all. It is a story of an empty tomb discovered by a woman from whom Jesus had cast out seven demons (cf. Lk 8:2), and two fishermen. Awestruck by the simplicity of these circumstances, we are inspired to adore the profound humility of God who invites – but never forces – us to respond to him in faith.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Although we cannot know exactly why God chose to arrange the events this way, today's second reading offers a hint: "For you have died," writes St. Paul, "and your life is hidden with Christ in God," This world which we consider home, and everything that comes to mind when we say "my life" - these are only shadows of the life that is found in Christ alone. Like the disciples in the Gospel, we are meant to gaze past the outward appearances of our mundane and sometimes painfilled lives and, with the eyes of faith, place our hope in the true life that comes from God. But how often we forget! How often we live as if this world were all there was, without hope for eternal life! We are not alone in forgetting God's promises; Mary Magdalene and the disciples do not seem to expect Jesus' resurrection - even though he had repeatedly predicted it. At the tomb, they sought a dead body; but Jesus wished to offer them his life. We, likewise, must desire and seek his life by laying aside everything that does not lead us to him.

REJOICE

Alleluia! Christ is risen! Although we don't place our hope in this life, marking the Church's feasts in our homes and families can inspire us to seek "what is above" by giving us a foretaste of the joys of heaven. Today through next Sunday, as we celebrate the "Easter Octave," every day is Easter Day! Use simple reminders – decorations, an extra treat, an additional time of prayer – to rejoice each day of the Octave.


