Augustinians of the Assumption Mission Appeal Collection June 21/22

From the very beginning, the Augustinians of the Assumption (Assumptionists) have been engaged in a wide variety of apostolic works. All that advances the coming of the Reign of God has always been deemed worthy of our apostolic energy.

It's a preference for poor, in response to the Gospel and to the Church calling us today to be on their side. For us too it's a consequence of our own vow to live as poor men. Some will dedicate themselves full-time to this work: with marginalized people of every kind, in hospitals and in prisons, "worker priests" or volunteers in different organizations ... But all of us try to live in union with the poor, because "the poor will always be with us", because the poor are too often neglected even within the Church. This is a bias that the Assumption encourages.

Our Province of North America is specifically responsible for the missions in East Africa (Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania), Mexico and the Philippines. We provide personnel and financial assistance that is indispensable in order to maintain our charitable works (schools and nurseries) and formation programs for both laity and clergy in these countries. Many of our apostolates in these countries specifically work to better the living conditions of the impoverished brothers and sisters we live with and minister to. In the Philippines, we sponsor education and aid programs for underprivileged villages both in the Manila area and in other mission centers. Our parish in Orizaba, Veracruz Mexico ministers to an underserved indigenous community.

Happy Father's Day



Dear Parishioners,

Appropriately, the Church celebrates Trinity Sunday on the Sunday following Pentecost, or "Holy Spirit" Sunday, since the earthly work of Jesus has been completed, and He has sent the

Holy Spirit as He promised. The "Community of the Trinity" is now celebrated as the relationship between God - Father and Creator, God - Son and Redeemer, and God - Spirit and Sanctifier. If God the Father's plan is to live in community, so it should be with us as the Father's children, as the brothers and sisters of the Son and the Spirit. We are not designed or destined to live our Christian lives alone and isolated. God did not create Adam to be alone. God created Eve to begin a community of persons with Adam. Jesus did not preach, teach, and heal alone. From the beginning of His public ministry Jesus called 12 particular men around Him, as well as inviting many other men and women to be His disciples, or student followers. So just as Jesus from the beginning formed a community around Him, so did God the Father form a community of Himself, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit from the beginning of time. Our most important celebration of our faith, the Mass, is not celebrated normally by the priest alone, or just with a server or two; the Mass can be celebrated privately by the priest, but this is the exception and not the rule. Mass is celebrated with at least several people in addition to the priest to symbolize Jesus' coming into the world for the salvation of the many, not just the few. It is not easy to try and explain the Holy Trinity - it never has and never will be - it is one of the "Mysteries of our faith." It's not something for us to understand fully, but to embrace fully in faith and trust God's wisdom.

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Prov 8:22-31 | Rom 5:1-5 | Jn 16:12-15

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Between two people who love each other, speech often gives way to silence. But first, in order to nourish love, there must be a mutual exchange of words. Persons in love wish to share their most intimate secrets so that they might know and be known. In an act deserving of our endless wonder, God disclosed his most intimate secret to us: He is a communion of Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — who relate to each other in an eternal exchange of love. St. Thomas Aquinas insisted that the Trinity is not a reality we could have figured out on our own (in contrast to, for example, God’s existence — which we can know simply by examining creation). God had to *reveal* his Trinitarian nature to us. While humanity was wandering further and further away from him over the millennia after the Fall, God was preparing us for the revelation of the Son and the Holy Spirit. This is what Jesus is announcing in today’s Gospel: “Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that [the Holy Spirit] will take from what is mine and declare it to you.” To his bewildered disciples, Jesus is expressing God’s intention to communicate his identity to us — an unmerited gift which he offers simply because he loves us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

This is our inheritance as Christians: God has revealed himself to us out of love. Once we’ve assented to this truth, we can no longer dismiss the mystery of the Holy Trinity as “above my theological paygrade.” One who loves is not bothered that the beloved always remains a mystery; instead, he or she is content to remain in wonder and seeks to enter more deeply into the exchange of love. For us, this means responding to God’s gift of himself with reverence, gratitude, and obedience to his will. We approach him in prayer with the respectful but confident attitude of a child who knows itself to be deeply loved; we listen to him, express our thanksgiving for his gift, and seek to know his will for us.

PRAY

Be attentive to the ways God is revealing himself and his love for you in your daily life. Discover that *everything* is an expression of his care: answered prayers, a kind word given or received, the beauty of nature — even crosses which induce us to turn to him for help! Take a few minutes each day to thank God for his gifts.
