Capital Campaign News

- An update of what has been pledged for the Capital Campaign so far:
 - o Holy Angels: \$57,155.00 (52.33% of our goal) 23 donors

How might we respond to those who ask us about the scandals of the Church?

- Agree that it is a terrible thing that children are abused by ANYONE but especially by the CLERGY or their PARENTS or their FAMILY members. This is an occasion that ought to never happen and we must always stand up in defense of children. Child abuse isn't all of it....abortion, poverty, poor education etc. are part of neglect and abuse of our children and any effort to stop it is pleasing to God and to our children.
- Agree that it is unacceptable that those in leadership, PRIESTS, BISHOPS, TEACHERS, CIVIL
 AUTHORITIES... anyone in the presence of children in a variety of ways who may be failing to protect a child's
 innocence and their youth. It must stop at any price.
- We can respond by making a clear, precise and truthful report to law authorities and to the bishops' office when
 we see something wrong. (Remember, making an untruthful response is to be as evil as those who are
 honestly harming our children.)
- We can respond by working to be more faithful in how we live our own Catholic lives. God's justice will always
 win in these cases of scandal and in any case of sin, including our own. More frequent confession, receiving
 communion worthily and never in serious sin, and following the teachings of the faith as closely as you are able.
