Parish Cemetery Issues: It has come to our attention that the cemetery properties, potentially at any parish, are being used at night for reasons other than the visitation of graves. (*We think drug sales.*) The police have been alerted and as a warning to others please know that these properties are being watched. If you are in the cemetery while it is closed you could be accused of something you may not want to be known publicly. The closure of the cemeteries for the winter months means that it is not accessible and thereby CLOSED. Although this may not have been enforced before, please know that this also means for the visitation of graves. Should there be injury or harm to anyone, parishioner or otherwise, while in the cemetery while it is closed, the liability for injury, theft or "other" reasons is the onus of the person there illegally.
