

Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. July 28th

One of the greatest gifts God has given us is the grace of generosity. Our Lord Jesus Christ wants us to practice the same thing in serving him and in our brothers and sisters. Generosity is a spiritual investment. When we put in more, the return is great. I describe the act of generosity as sowing a seed in a field. When you sow more, you harvest plenty. The same thing applies to our Christian life. Just imagine sowing a single seed of a tomato, orange, or any kind of seed and wait till it starts bearing fruit. After harvesting, sit down and calculate how many seeds you harvested? Maybe hundreds, thousands or just say uncountable. In today's gospel Jesus took five loaves and feed more than five thousand people. May the Lord give us the grace to be generous to people in need.
