JUBILEE 2025 HOLY YEAR (Pilgrims of Hope)

What is the Papal Bull of Indication? The term 'bull' originates from the lead seal, known as bulla in Latin. It refers to a Papal decree which outlines the purpose and spirit of the Holy Year.

What does the Papal Bull for the 2025 Jubilee Year tell us? The Bull is titled "Spes non confundit" (Hope does not disappoint) and urges us to look for signs of hope in the world around us and work for peace and justice. In the document Pope Francis writes: "If we really wish to prepare a path to peace in our world, let us commit ourselves to remedying the remote causes of injustice, settling unjust and unpayable debts, and feeding the hungry." What is a Holy Door? A Holy Door is one of the usually sealed entrances that lead into the major basilicas of Rome. The beginning of the Jubilee Year is marked by the opening of the Holy Door of St Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. It is only during a Jubilee Year that these doors are opened. Three other papal basilica doors will be opened and one prison door during the Holy Year.

What do Catholics do during a Jubilee Year? The Jubilee Year is an opportunity to respond to God's call to turn to him and to pursue justice. Often people will go on pilgrimage during a Jubilee year, to Rome or another holy site. Pope Francis writes: "Pilgrimage is of course a fundamental element of every Jubilee event. Setting out on a journey is traditionally associated with our human quest for meaning in life. A pilgrimage on foot is a great aid for rediscovering the value of silence, effort and simplicity of life." (Spes non confundit #5)
