Dear Parishioners.

As you know, the Diocese of Ogdensburg, like many dioceses across the country, faces the challenges of an increasing number of aging priests, fewer new vocations, and declining Mass attendance. In order to continue providing the sacraments—especially the Eucharist—many parishes have been asked to merge or to come together under one pastor as part of a Pastoral Care Area.

This planning process has been underway for several years. Many parishes have already submitted their plans, and some have been implemented this past summer. Others remain "on the shelf," ready to be put in place when needed.


The process of bringing together Ellenburg, Lyon Mountain, Mooers Forks, and Altona under one Pastoral Care Area with one pastor was delayed over the past year due to Fr. Jay's absence. We have now begun this important work. Meetings are taking place with trustees, parish and finance councils, and other parish leaders to review our ministries and to discern how we can best serve all of our parish communities with one pastor. This is not an easy task, but it is a necessary one.

We are obligated to present a plan to Bishop LaValley by this November. However, please keep in mind that we do not know when the plan will go into effect. It could be next year, or it may be several years from now, depending on pastoral needs as priests retire, are reassigned, or pass away.

This fall, there will be an opportunity for parishioners to offer feedback. Please watch the bulletin for the date and details.

Above all, we ask for your prayers—for Fr. Jay, Fr. Tojo, and for the parishioners of St. Bernard's, St. Edmund's, St. Ann's, and Holy Angels—as together we discern God's will for the future of our faith communities. We trust that the Holy Spirit will guide us through this process, drawing us closer together as one family in Christ, united in faith, hope, and love.
