## **Extra-Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion**

The bread of life, Holy Eucharist, is the source and summit of our faith and if there's one thing a faithful Catholic can do at least once a week, it would be to receive Holy Communion. Just like many of the other ministries we've talked about over the past couple of months this ministry is meant to provide assistance to the priest.

In the Catholic Church we receive the body and blood of Christ at every mass and due to shortage of priest and deacons the Church has instituted another ministry to help aid the priest in his ministry. The ministry of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion or EMHC is a special ministry that requires reverence and respect.

An extraordinary ministry of Holy Communion is just that: he or she is an "EXTRA" minister. The distribution of communion in years past was reserved for ordinary ministers i.e. priest, deacons, and acolytes. Because the body of

Christ (the Church) continues to grow and because not every Church has enough ordained ministers to distribute communion, we must rely on the help of lay ministers.

An extraordinary minister of Holy Communion must be a Catholic in good standing with the Church. He/she must have received



all their sacraments and has attended the parish training for EMHCs. An EMHC must also have a desire for the Blessed Sacrament and be able to show reverence and respect to the precious body and blood before, during, and after the distribution of Holy Communion.

An EMHC is not just distributing crackers and wine; he/

she is distributing the precious Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ. Because they are sharing the Eucharist with gathered faithful they must have a manner that is worthy of Christ's presence. They must dress and carry themselves in a way that is worthy of holding Christ himself in his/her hands.

Granted no one is perfect, but a good extraordinary minister of communion is someone who strives for holiness and strives to live in accord with the will of God. This ministry is a very important ministry that comes with great responsibility.

If you have a desire for the Blessed Sacrament and a desire for Christ in the form of the bread and wine, consider being an EMHC.

Our parish is in great need for more extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. We need people like you with a love for the Blessed Sacrament and a desire to share Christ with others.

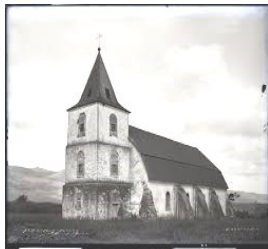

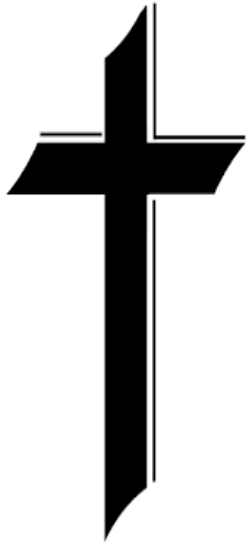
Both men and women are impacted and greatly benefit from retreats. Married couples, mothers, fathers, siblings and grandparents have come in search of peace and inner healing.
