# SUNDAY REFLECTION The Joy of Finding Christ By: Joshua Kapika

Merry Christmas! As we continue our joyful celebration of the Christmas Season, today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Today's gospel recalls the Joyful Mystery of Finding Jesus in the Temple.

If you are someone who often prays the rosary, you know that the finding Jesus in the temple is the last of the joyful mysteries. The fruit of the mystery is Piety. What we can learn from this mystery and today's reading is that we should always find joy in encountering Christ and that we should be filled with a joyful dedication to being with him in prayer and worship.

We might often question how such a thing could happen to Mary and Joseph, leaving behind their only child, but that is not the focus of today's

Take five minutes at the start of your day to offer a simple prayer, say grace before meals, read a few verses from the bible, or give thanks to God before bed. These simple acts help us to form a devoted and pious life modeling it after Christ himself.


