EPIPHANY OF THE LORD ~ JANUARY 2ND, 2022

As we enter into a new year, it is common to make “New Year’s resolutions”, or to make plans for the coming months. As we go about those preparations, let us take time to reflect on the third chapter of St. Paul’s letter to the Colossians.

Brothers and sisters: Put on, as God’s chosen ones, holy and beloved, heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another, if one has a grievance against another; as the Lord has forgiven you, so must you also do. And over all these put on love, that is, the bond of perfection. And let the peace of Christ control your hearts, the peace into which you were also called in one Body. And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Dom Prosper Gueranger, Abbot of Solesmes, had the following commentary on this passage, which we would do well to reflect upon:

If we would attain Charity, the bond of perfection which unites all Christians together in the one great family of God, we must pay heed to those virtues which the Epistle puts before us. We must be full of mercy, benignity, humility, modesty, and patience; we must bear with one another, after the example of the Incarnate Word. Then the peace of Christ will dwell not only in our hearts, but in those around us, and our homes will truly become like that of Nazareth, where Mary and Joseph were ever singing in grace to the Lord God.

Finally, as we are finished with the holidays, we return to our regular week-end schedule.
