The Regional Director of Enrollment will help you and your child(ren) transition to another Catholic school for the 2023-2024 school year. You can reach your Regional Director of Enrollment at the email address and/or phone number listed above, or by calling our bilingual parent helpline at (646) 794-2885 between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday-Friday.

All families – including those not previously receiving assistance ~ will have a chance to apply for financial assistance as part of their application to a new participating school. If your child(ren) is receiving financial assistance for the 2022-2023 school year, you are assured of receiving an award for 2023-24 at the new participating Regional school once you complete your application.

To ease the transition, each child who transfers from a closing school to a participating school will receive a one-time \$500 Transition Grant that will be applied to their family's tuition account during the 2023-2024 academic year.
