"TO JESUS THROUGH MARY"



4th SUNDAY OF EASTER

There are so many things to think about in today's readings. I suggest that you read them again privately and reflect on their meaning.

The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles underscores the divinity of Jesus and reminds us to repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. We are also commanded to save ourselves from this corrupt generation! The second reading informs us that Christ's life and self-giving/sacrifice is the model that we are to follow during these few short years we have on earth. By His wounds we are healed! But we have to believe and have faith to be healed. I see a great challenge for me in this reading as St. Peter tells us to be like Jesus when He was insulted (He returned no insult). We live in a very broken world today, and we all need healing! In chapter 7 of the Rule of St. Benedict (on humility), we are told that the ninth step to humility is controlling our tongue and learning to love silence. St. Benedict points out that Scripture warns that, "In a flood of words you will not avoid sinning (Prov. 10:19)."

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that He, and He alone, is the gate through which we must enter if we are to be saved. Also, His sheep recognize His voice. Do we recognize His voice? Do we really believe that what Jesus says is true? Do we put Jesus at the top of our priorities?

All of the readings today revolve around the theme of the centrality of Christ in our lives. Praised be Jesus Christ, now and forever!

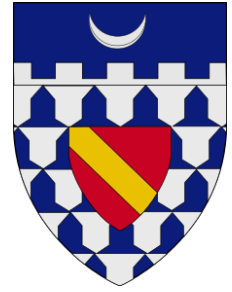

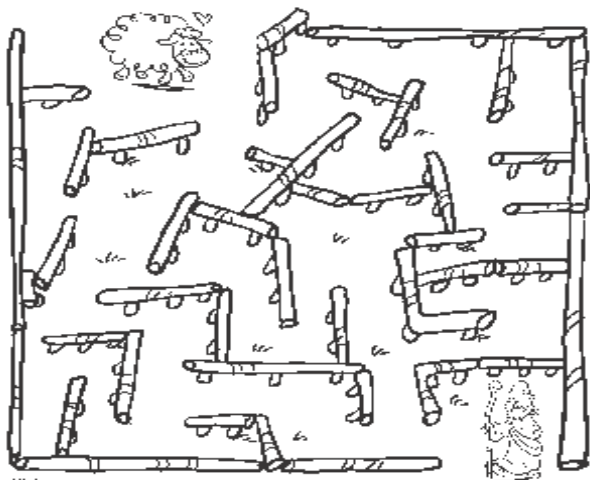
