

To Jesus thru Mary Led by the Spirit

So we begin another season of Lent. Lent requires more of us today. Basically, it asks us to accept adult responsibility for our own spiritual growth. One of the traditional practice in Lent is giving up something. That something does not necessarily have to be food or an activity we like.

We are called to give up whatever is sinful in our lives, what keeps us from being close to Christ. And once we give it up, we are supposed to give it up for good (that's the nub you might say-eh).

The Gospel this week tells us of Jesus being led by the Spirit in the desert, tempted by Satan. Jesus struggles with everything that it means to be human. He emerges from the desert proclaiming the Gospel "Repent & Believe."

So this year the challenge for us is to say what we are going to give up - I hope it is time by participating in the "33 days to morning Glory." Let the Spirit lead us to like it led Mary to say yes to God's will in our lives.

Jesus, by his proclamation, asks us to take on a new perspective of God with us or dwelling among us. Like Mary his mother we only have to take the words "thy will be done" and journey with him to glory.


LIGHT A CANDLE
