



SLDM...A Look Back in Time Part 5 of a Series A School is on the Horizon...

Our biggest endeavor, other than getting the Parish off the ground in 1978, was the possibility of building a school that would serve our children and help perpetuate our future. It was always a dream that Father Donald Eder had in the back of his mind to somehow pull off this miracle. We had been on a mission of growth and spirituality for almost 20 years now. The only piece of the puzzle that was missing was the elusive dream of a parochial school to serve our kids. The cost alone was staggering for a little country Parish trying to compete with the ever-growing and accomplished HSE school system. The one thing we could provide, however, was that spiritual aspect of our Faith inculcated into the everyday learning process. And so, the seeds of a dream were planted in late 1997.

According to diocesan mandates we had to have 50% of the building costs and the first years operating capital in hand to begin this daunting process. This alone almost took down our sails. We had always paid for everything with a small down payment and a "finance the rest" mentality. We had no real "Heavy Hitters" or "Sugar Daddies" that would provide those large capital resources to help underwrite this. But perseverance, prayer, selfless giving and extreme dedication would overcome the odds of pulling off this miracle of faith. But, we knew We could do It!


We put together a small team of "in house" construction, architectural, engineering and electrical professionals to begin the process of developing a footprint to match what we could not only afford, but what would fit in the acreage we had available. We had developed several designs and even implemented different class structures to coincide with what the diocese demanded. In the end we knew we would have Pre K, Kindergarten, and Classrooms for grades 1-8 to satisfy every combination of grade levels, as well as specialized areas such as labs and computer classrooms. The gym was a Go/No Go situation for a period of time and it was finally determined through additional fund raising to be built as a must have facility.

So, all in all, the following people met for two years every week to develop, design, and implement the Architectural Blueprints for our SLDM Catholic School. Father Bert Woolson who arrived at our parish in the latter part of 1998 as our Pastor/Administrator, Jim Rogers, Bruce Franklin, Tom Montgomery, Mike Noll and Dave Kinder. We were the Team that was entrusted with the task of taking paper to a structured physical reality.

As we prayed and asked for God's intervention in making this aspiration the reality we all wanted, we did through His Grace accomplish our purpose. That "First Shovel" went into the ground on August 15 1999. And, just one year later on a beautiful 17th day of August in the year of 2000, we opened the doors to our beautiful new school. It was like something very special had arrived at SLDM. It was indeed a mystical, spiritual and grand occasion. As I watched all of the children process to Mass on that first day, it made all the efforts that so many people had put forth, worth every minute we had all spent in making this dream come true.

We do have 501 kids now enrolled in our school. Learning to not only love and understand our Faith, but to receive an education that will give them the base to which they will build into a lifetime of learning. Yes, 19 years have now gone by since those daunting days of trying to figure out how to get this accomplished. I think we all did a good job and those kids will someday look back and say it was the best of times. I know it was for all of us.


STEPHEN MINISTERS

SALLY BURTON FOOD PANTRY OPPORTUNITY




