

SGO Gifts

St. Louis de Montfort School has partnered with the Institute for Quality Education (IQE) as our official Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). By making your gift through IQE and designating it to St. Louis de Montfort Catholic School, you will be providing needs-based scholarships to eligible students. As a donor, not only will you provide much-needed scholarships, but you also will qualify for a 50% INDIANA STATE TAX CREDIT. Additionally, the total amount of your gift is eligible for a federal tax deduction.

As an example, if you make a gift of \$1,000 directly through IQE and designate St. Louis de Montfort Catholic School, an estimated scenario is:

Gift amount: \$1000
 State Tax Credit: \$500 + Federal Tax Savings (30%): \$300 = Total Tax Savings: \$800
 After-tax Cost of Your Gift = \$200




