I would often think I wasn't holy enough or maybe I didn't understand my faith well enough because I never had a cloud speak to me. I never saw a burning bush. I never had fire appear over my head or heard the voice (as I imagine it to be similar to James Earl Jones or Morgan Freeman) saving "YOU ARE MY CHILD."

While it's true, none of those things have ever happened to me, I did have a moment in my life back in college when I picked up a shift at the bar for no reason and ran into a woman I'd later have the pleasure of calling my wife. I also recall a moment when I was leading a group at a national conference and had outside food delivered. For some odd reason, we were the only group in the long hallway that was asked by the convention center security to eat outside, when as we got outside met a homeless man and were able to share our food with him.

See, as I sit back and think about faith, it's not the burning bush or immense clouds formed overhead that have shaped my life. However, it's those moments of having something amazing come out of the simply mundane.


Working with youth, and more so just being a dad to 3 amazing kids, allows me to see Christ in the mundane. I no longer search for the clouds to come over head (probably because it'd scare me), but also because I now know that's not how God speaks to us. He speaks to us in the quiet of our hearts and in the turmoil that we go through.

As this week continues for yourself, please don't look for a cloud, a bush, or any inanimate object to come alive, but rather quiet your heart and just ask God, "What can I do for you today?" He might want you to share food, help someone move, be a shoulder for someone to cry on, or simply be present to a hurting kid, but he does want you.

As St. Teresa of Avila stated, "Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which he looks compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which he blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are his body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours."

Go and be Christ's voice this week for someone else to hear.



SAFE AND SACRED TRAINING




