

Rejoice in the Lord always. I say it again: rejoice!

These are the words from St. Paul to the Philippians on this Third Sunday of Advent, also called Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete is a Latin word that means "rejoice!" On this Gaudete Sunday, we light the pink candle of our Advent wreathes and the clergy wear rose-colored vestments, all to symbolize the virtue of joy.

In our Gospel this weekend, we continue to hear of John of Baptist preparing the way of the Lord. How have we done this Advent season to prepare our own hearts for the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ? Gaudete Sunday usually marks the midway point of our Advent season, although with Christmas falling on a Tuesday this year, we miss much of the Fourth Week of Advent. Regardless of how well we've prepared ourselves thus far, we still have time to slow down and turn away from the cultural pressures to busyness and anxiety of the 'holiday season' and turn toward our Lord in prayerful anticipation. This coming week, St. Louis de Montfort is hosting a communal reconciliation service on Thursday evening — what a better way to cleanse our hearts and prepare the way of the Lord!

On this Gaudete Sunday, let us express our joy in recognizing how near His nativity is and sing at the top of our voices along with all the angels and hosts of heaven, Rejoice!






