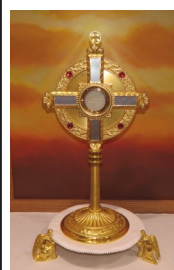

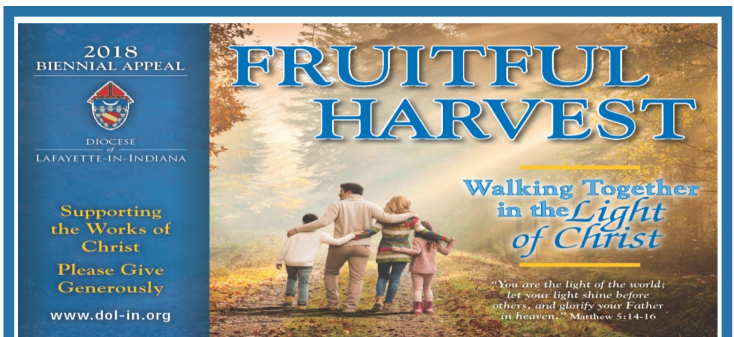
ST. VINCENT DE PAUL – NEEDS YOU!

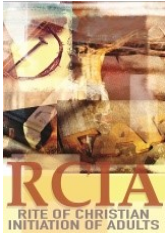

OPENINGS IN ST. LOUIS DE MONTFORT CATHOLIC SCHOOL'S PRE-K1 (2-DAY) PROGRAM

Our Pre-K Program is for children who are 4 by August 1st of the school year. This Tuesday and Thursday program starts at 9:00am and concludes at 3:10pm. Cost for the school year, August 15, 2019 – May 29, 2020 is \$2,160.

Students experience in class curriculum as well as additional activities physical education and music. An optional hot lunch program is available. An afternoon rest period is offered to the students along with a free choice period.

Wellness Corner

Heat Stroke and Heat Exhaustion

- Heat stroke is an emergency and occurs when a person's body temperature rises rapidly – to 103 degrees or higher within 10-15 minutes. Sweating mechanisms fail, so the body is unable to cool down.
- Some signs include red, hot and dry skin (no sweating), rapid and strong pulse, throbbing headache, dizziness, nausea, and confusion.
- Act quickly if someone has these symptoms, as it could be a life-threatening situation. Call for immediate medical assistance, and get the individual to a shady area. Take steps to cool him/her rapidly, such as sponging with cool water, spraying with cool water from a garden hose, or placing in a shower or tub with cool water.
- Heat exhaustion is not as severe as heat stroke, but can progress to it. It develops when someone is exposed to high temperatures over several days and fluid replacement is inadequate.
- Signs include heavy sweating, headache, skin that is pale, cool and moist, muscle cramps, fast and weak pulse, dizziness, fast and shallow breathing, nausea and vomiting.
- To cool the body, drink cool, nonalcoholic beverages (alcohol and caffeinated drinks can lead to further dehydration). Also, seek an air-conditioned environment and rest. Choose lightweight clothing and take a cool shower or bath.
