


CARDINAL 50/50 CLUB





Suicide Awareness and Prevention

National Suicide Prevention Week this year is September 8-14, 2019. The American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP) has Out of the Darkness community walks across the country to raise awareness. Indianapolis has a walk on Saturday, September 14 at White River State Park. For more information, you can email indyoutofthedarkness@gmail.com.

- Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death in the US, and in 2017, 47,173 Americans died by suicide.
- There is no single cause for suicide, although it most often occurs as a result of feelings of hopelessness and despair. These feelings may be due to a combination of health and environmental stressors. Some factors that increase risk include:
 - Depression (especially if it is untreated), substance use problems, anxiety disorders, bipolar disorder, and schizophrenia
 - Traumatic brain injury and serious physical conditions, such as chronic pain
 - Stressful life events (divorce, financial crisis, and transitions involving loss and rejection)
 - Prolonged stress (harassment, bullving, unemployment, relationship problems)
 - Access to lethal means (firearms, drugs)
 - Exposure to graphic and sensationalized accounts of suicide
