Today's readings are all about hope and trust that what the Lord has promised, he will deliver. There cannot be a more powerful example of this hope and trust than that demonstrated by Martha in the Gospel passage. And, to me, how ironic this is. The last time we encountered Martha in the Gospels, she was beside herself with anxiety over things to be done, while her sister Mary sat at Jesus' feet, absorbing every word he spoke. In today's passage, Mary sat at home while Martha went to meet Jesus. Did Mary possibly believe she had misplaced her faith in Jesus? Maybe, or maybe not. She was mourning the death of her brother, after all.



Reflecting on this through the lens of the COVID-19 pandemic, I can't help but consider that the whole world is currently mourning not only those lives lost, but also the effects of this disease on nearly every aspect of our lives. And to us here in the US, the anxiety generated by the disease itself is only compounded by the necessary infringements on our lifestyles. Watching the ever-increasing numbers of confirmed cases, it becomes easier and easier to be tempted to lose hope. Some may wonder where is God in all of this?

Friends, as Jesus was there, weeping with Martha over the loss of his friend Lazarus, he is here with us in this time of loss and confusion and mourning. He is here, wherever you see neighbors who just ten days ago barely acknowledged one another now actively reaching out to ask "How can I help you?" He is here in the friend who goes out of her way to pack items needed by someone hundreds of miles away and ships them to her. Jesus is here in our parish community as we find creative ways to continue to evangelize one another and our community in our various ministries.

Through this lens, the reading from Ezekiel comes into sharp contrast. "O my people, I will open your graves and have you rise from them, and bring you back to the land of Israel. Then you shall know that I am the LORD, when I open your graves and have you rise from them, O my people." "I have promised, and I will do it, says the LORD."

Brothers and sisters, at this time, I ask you to consider whether we had each, in many ways, entombed ourselves in our own interests, losing sight of the needs of those around us. And consider, through this current time of loss and anxiety, whether the Lord is fulfilling his promise here in our time.

Let us never lose hope in the love and mercy of God.

During this difficult time concerning the COVID-19 virus, I wanted to communicate with you our most recent updates for SLDM. Our parish staff will be continuing to look at new ways to support your needs and continue to share the faith, so please stay tuned.



In conjunction with recommendations from the CDC, the city of Fishers, and Bishop Doherty, the following directives are in effect at SLDM.

Until further notice, all public Masses and meetings at St. Louis de Montfort have been suspended or will be available online until further notice.

Additionally:

- The Church and Parish Office will be closed until further notice.
- **The Tabernacle with the Blessed Sacrament will be located inside the doorway under the carport. Parishioners may drive up and Adore the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle from their cars.**
- Celebration of the following Sacraments: Baptisms, Confirmation and Holy Matrimony are postponed until further notice.
- **Reconciliation (Confessions), will be offered on an appointment-only basis, as needed. Please call the parish office and leave a voicemail for either Fr. Pat (ext. 230) or Fr. Travis (ext. 242). They will return your call to set up a time.**
- Funerals will be postponed when possible.
- Our hope is to keep the food pantry open normal hours in the coming weeks. The food will be brought outside for a drive thru distribution.
- The Bishop is recommending that the faithful make an act of Spiritual Communion.
As an example: My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
- The faithful are encouraged to read the Sunday readings at home and pray the rosary.
- The priests will be saying private Masses which will include all the Mass intentions.
- The parish bulletin will be available, as always, on the parish website.
- A priest will be on call and can be reached by calling the emergency number 317-965-6522.
- Friday night Stations of the Cross has been cancelled.

St. Louis de Montfort Catholic School will be closed until May 1st.

CYO—All CYO sports have been cancelled until further notice.

- Mini Cardinal Basketball season has been cancelled by OLMC, including all practices
- Men's Sunday night basketball and Saturday night co-ed volleyball is cancelled until further notice.







THE 6 CHARACTERISTICS OF AN EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP FOR LENT – COMMITTED

I remember Jim Valvano, Jimmy V to many, saying the iconic words, “Don’t give up; you can never give up.” The former coach of the NC State men’s basketball team was dying of cancer, yet he refused to throw in the towel and give in to his disease. His words exemplified the best of the human spirit we all share. Sometimes, living out those words seem much more difficult than saying them. These words are also important for our faith life. The life Jesus calls us to is not easy. When working toward a life of greater generosity and surrender of all to God, we are prone to fall flat on our face many times. We are not called to this life only when we are strong. It is how we respond when times are the most difficult that truly defines us as disciples and stewards. The world may think we are down for the count, but rising again gives testimony that in Christ we are stronger. Commitment takes a willingness to do the things needed to get stronger and build our spiritual muscles. We cannot expect to find success in the spiritual life unless we continue to work on our resolve and grow in our knowledge of the faith. A marathon runner would never be able to make it to the finish line unless they have trained and prepared in advance. We must work hard to stay the course and prepare for the race at hand. No matter what this life may have in store for us, we are called to not give up. God will never give up on us. —Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS


