### **From the Desk of Father Haan...**

## MAKING A HOUSE A HOME

The topic of “home” has been on my mind lately for several reasons.

- 1) My siblings are spread throughout the country. My brother and his wife live in northern Virginia, and my sister and her husband currently reside outside of Nashville, Tennessee. My parents try to make the rounds, but it’s a special (and rare) occasion when all us kids are **back home** under the same roof. Dad and Mom say that the house is a little empty until everyone is home. Our next chance will be later in July, and we are already looking forward to it with excitement.
- 2) This is true at St. Louis de Montfort Catholic Church, as well. In my first ten months, so many in our parish family have been scattered and isolated during the pandemic. Particularly in the last two months, people have been steadily returning to Mass, and as pastor this warms my heart. It’s not quite the same until all the children are back home. If you are newly returning to Mass, **welcome home**. Our parish should be our family, our spiritual refuge, and our spiritual home. It’s where you belong, and we are glad that you are here.
- 3) On that note, a worthy reflection for each of us: we know that visitors come to our parish nearly every weekend. What is your role in making a visitor to our parish feel at home? Your smile, your simple greeting, introducing yourself after Mass, an invitation to join you for coffee, your effort to make room in the pew all makes our house (God’s house) a home. I know that each of us have our favorite pew spot, but I sometimes feel that sitting on the edge of the pew and making others climb over us isn’t quite hospitable. We want visitors to feel at **home**. Isn’t this what all of us want when we are in unfamiliar settings – a simple welcome?
- 4) As you probably know, last summer the St. Louis de Montfort rectory (priest residence) on our campus was remodeled and repurposed into a pre-school. The building has proven to be an answered prayer: our pre-school program is thriving, with approximately 60 students enrolled this coming fall. But of course, this wonderful pre-school on our campus has meant that Father Sean and I have been without a home! For the past ten months, we have been living in a rental home in Carmel, but I am excited to share that the parish has purchased a nearby house as the new St. Louis de Montfort rectory. Father Sean and I moved in last weekend with the help of a team of generous Knights of Columbus. Located just two minutes south of our parish campus, we pray this will be **the home for SLDM priests for decades to come**.

## Scholarship Granting Organization

By far, one of the best ways to make a Catholic education accessible and affordable for families who qualify, is to make a gift via our partner Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). It not only helps us to meet the need of families who express a desire for their children to receive a Catholic education. It also is a highly tax-advantageous way of making your gift. By making your gift, designated to St. Louis de Montfort, through our SGO you can receive a state tax credit equal to 50% of the donation amount. Your gift also qualifies as a charitable deduction on federal tax returns.

As an example, a \$1,000 donation to the SGO would qualify for a \$500 state tax credit and a \$220 federal deduction (assuming a 22% tax bracket). This makes the true "cost" of the gift \$280 after the tax savings.

While there is no cap on donation amounts made by individuals or corporations, gifts will receive the state tax credit only if there are funds available. Currently, there is only about \$5.3 million in available tax credits in the fund. You can visit the Indiana Department of Revenue site to check the status of remaining tax credits.

Each year, gifts designated to SLDM via the SGO are combined with a parish subsidy to award approximately \$100,000 in financial aid. We anticipate an increase next year in the number of families who will qualify and in those families who will seek financial assistance—whether current or incoming.

Making a donation, of any size, to the SGO assures the gift of a Catholic education is possible for those families for whom it is out-of-reach financially. It also eases church and school resources to free them up for other areas of need within the budget.
