How It Works

Pick a Date	Visit the Signup Genius and pick a date that works for your household. Simply sign up
Pick up the Statue	You will pick up the statue on the day that your signup begins in the Church Narthex. The statue is under the picture of St. Louis de Montfort to the right of the Church entrance in the Narthex.
Pray the Novena	The statue comes with a binder that has the prayers for each day. Go to DAY ONE OF THE NOVENA and then pray the prayers with your household.
Return the Statue	At the end of your scheduled sign up we ask you to return the statue to the Narthex on the table under the St. Louis de Montfort picture. It is on the right of the entry way or narthex of the Church.

History of the Traveling Statue

Year of St. Joseph	In the Year of St. Joseph (December 8 th 2020 - December 2021) a member of our Church expressed an idea of the traveling statue. The priest asked "What statue should we use?" But the parishioner did not know. Later that same day another parishioner donated a statue of St. Joseph to the parish without knowing of the previous conversation.
Novena	A novena is a nine day prayer that usually asks for the intercession of a Saint for a specific intension. This tradition of a nine day prayer or NOVENA began from the Acts of the Apostles Chapter 1-2. Jesus asked the apostles to pray and promised to send the advocate. The apostles prayed for nine days and on the 10 th day the Holy Spirit came - Pentecost.
