### OCIA vs RCIA

The name of the process for becoming Catholic has changed.

The Unitied States of Cathoic Bishops (USCCB) officially changed the initialism of RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation to OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation). The Catholic Faith has a long tradition of using abbreviations in the original latin. For example: The document by St. John Paul II on Redemptive Suffering is listed as *SD* because the latin is Savifici Doloris. The dogmatic constitution on the Church is listed as *DV* because of the Latin title Dei Verbum.

Since the promulgation of the Christian Initiation process after Vatican II the title in latin was ORDO INITATIONS CHRISTIANE ADULTORUM. "The name change applies both to the process by which one enters the Church and the book that contains the ritual text and prayers for those steps." (CNA Newsletter: 11/18/21).

Book by book, the bishops have been updating the language and translation of the different sacraments since St. John Paul II set it in motion) in May of 2001. He asked that their be an effort to translate the document to the closest Latin liturgical texts.

There are slight revision in the new OCIA document and those will be put into effect by Lent of 2025.
