

# Frequently Asked Questions about VBS 2026

- **What date is VBS?**
  - June 22 - 26, 2026
  
- **What time does VBS begin and end?**
  - VBS for ALL grades (PreK through 5th) will run from 9:00am - 12:00pm.  
  
\*There is an optional \$10 addition for your child to stay for lunch and recess from 12:00pm - 1:00pm.
  
- **What should my child bring to VBS?**
  - Comfortable clothes and shoes they can run and get dirty in, a refillable water bottle labeled with their name, and a fun attitude!
  - ***If you've registered for the additional lunch/recess time, your child will also need to pack a lunch.*** Snacks will be provided, but NOT lunch. Lunches will not be refrigerated or heated up.
  
- **What should my child wear on a water day?**
  - Friday is a water day for PreK - 5th Grade. Please have your child dress in a modest bathing suit, with their clothes on top. They should also bring a towel and a change of clothes in a bag labeled with their name.
  
- **What happens if it rains?**
  - We are praying for beautiful weather, but if we have a rainy day we will bring all outdoor stations inside.
  
- **If I am a volunteer, when should I arrive?**
  - As a volunteer, please arrive at 8:30am. This will help us organize the day and be ready to greet the children at 9:00am.

- **Are snacks or water being provided?**
  - There will be snacks during the morning. Please have your child bring their own refillable water bottle, labeled with their name.
  
- **How old does my child need to be to participate?**
  - VBS is open for Preschoolers (4 years old as of September 1st 2026) to 5th Grade. All preschoolers need to be able to use the restroom independently.
  
- **Do volunteers require a registration fee?**
  - If you are interested in volunteering, please email Kaitlyn Armiger, [karmiger@sldmfishers.org](mailto:karmiger@sldmfishers.org). Teen volunteers are not required to pay. If you are an adult volunteer, your child's participation fee will be waived.
  
- **Do volunteers need to bring their own lunch?**
  - Maybe. If you are a teen or adult volunteer, volunteering for VBS and staying for the lunch/recess addition, you will need to bring a packed lunch every day.

- **How old does my child need to be to volunteer?**
  - All 6th graders and up are welcome to volunteer. We are happy to sign off on any volunteer hours you may need for school!
  
- **How do I know what group my child is in?**
  - Groups are organized by grade level. Your child's group is what grade they will be entering in the Fall of 2026.
