

Looking ahead to 2018...What is my greatest hope or desire for what 2018 might bring? What is the one virtue I most hope to grow in during the upcoming year?

Which people in my life is the Lord inviting me to grow stronger in my relationship with this year? What aspect of the practice of my Catholic faith is in most need of improving during 2018?

While these questions are only a guide, they may help you to make the upcoming year a happy and holy year.
