Century Club Update


Our St. Vincent de Paul Parish Century Club will be restarting again soon, with signup sessions after Masses on the weekend of 10/15-16.

As a reminder, this weekend is the third of our themed donation weekends. We are collecting **gift certificates and lottery tickets.**


