## **Saint Augustine Aftercare/Activities Program**

- All students who are registered for **Aftercare** will receive:
  - Homework Assistance
  - Snack
  - Outside Playtime
  - Additionally, **Aftercare** students will have the opportunity to sign up for **three (3)** activities.

- Aftercare is costs \$1,875.00 per student.
- Saint Augustine Catholic School also offers non-Aftercare students **two (2)** afterschool activities designed to enhance their educational experience, which is automatically allotted through your child(ren)'s enrollment.
- There are **17** wide-ranging Aftercare activities to choose from as we continually look to add additional activities that further interests and appeals to our student body.
- **Aftercare begins Tuesday, September 3, 2024 from 3:45pm – 6:00pm.**
- **Afterschool Activities begin on Tuesday, October 15, 2024 from 3:45pm – 6:00pm.**

## **Afterschool Pick Up**

- St. Augustine Catholic School concludes at **3:30pm** each day.

- **Aftercare begins on Tuesday, September 3, 2024.**
- **Aftercare starts at 3:45pm** and concludes **promptly at 6:00pm** daily.
- Students not in Aftercare must be picked up **immediately** after the conclusion of the school day.
- There is a **15-minute** grace period between **3:30pm – 4:45pm** to pick up non-Aftercare students.
- A **\$30 Drop-In fee** will be charged to the school account on file for those **non-Aftercare** students picked up after 3:45 pm.
- **Afterschool Activities begin on Tuesday, October 15, 2024.**
- All Activities are paid for by the \$350 Activity Fee with paid in each students Mandatory Fees.
- **Most** activities begin at **3:45pm** and run for **1 hour** on designated days weekly.
- Students with activities starting directly after school dismissal are permitted to stay in Aftercare until their activity starts.
- At the conclusion of their activity, your child(ren) must be picked up **immediately** after or a \$30 Drop-in fee **WILL BE** charged.
