OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Recently we completed our Pastorate Vision Plan summer information sessions. We learned in last winter's sessions that some (including me) assumed people were more familiar with the plan and with the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate than they actually were.

This and my next bulletin column(s) will give summaries of those sessions. And, with the aim of "overcommunicating," we will continue to share information in the bulletin, at Mass, on our Pastorate website, and in other forms.

This week I'll describe the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate.

The Diocese of Lafayette in Indiana uses the term "pastorate" to describe an organization of parishes with one pastor, one Pastorate Leadership Team and one Pastoral Council. Parishioners form one faith community, called to share their gifts in the service of a shared mission. The Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate consists of St. Ambrose, St. Mary Alexandria, and St. Mary Anderson parishes, along with our two parochial schools and all the other ministries supported by our parishes.

The Pastorate is not a merger of the parishes or schools. To illustrate this, we have separate budgets for each of the three parishes and two schools. But we also have Pastorate staff whose work and ministry are not focused on any one parish, but on the whole Pastorate.

Our mission statement, developed by our Pastorate Leadership Team and Pastorate Pastoral Council, declares: "We, the Anderson-Alexandria Catholic Pastorate, united in Jesus Christ through His Word, the Sacraments, and the Eucharist, are called to joyfully proclaim His Gospel and lovingly serve His people."

We summarize the statement with these words: "Joyfully proclaim, lovingly serve."

We also have a Pastorate Logo. Several of you submitted ideas for the logo, and I am grateful. The logo colors are blue (for the Blessed Mother) and gold (for St. Ambrose). Over images of three churches and three crosses, is an arc or "bow." The arc does not depict any specific object, but evokes the sun, the moon, the Eucharistic host, a rainbow, and even an embrace. (One participant worried that it looked like an Islamic symbol.) Rather than define "what the arc means," we will let it remain "richly ambiguous" as it unites the images of the three churches.

We still have some finishing to do, e.g. inserting the correct script, "Pastorado Católico/Anderson-Alexandria/Catholic Pastorate." Then we will incorporate it into our bulletin, letterhead, website, etc. Stay tuned!

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM...

Recientemente finalizamos nuestras sesiones informativas de verano sobre el Plan de Visión del Pastorado. En las sesiones del invierno pasado, nos dimos cuenta de que algunos (incluyéndome a mí) asumíamos que la gente estaba más familiarizada con el plan y con el Pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria de lo que realmente estaba.

Esta columna del boletín y las próximas ofrecerán resúmenes de dichas sesiones. Y, con el objetivo de "sobrecomunicarnos," seguiremos compartiendo información en el boletín, en la misa, en el sitio web de nuestro Pastorado y de otras maneras.

Esta semana describiré el Pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria.

La Diócesis de Lafayette, Indiana, utiliza el término "pastorado" para describir una organización de parroquias con un párroco, un Equipo de Liderazgo del Pastorado y un Consejo Pastoral del Pastorado. Los feligreses forman una comunidad de fe, llamados a compartir sus dones al servicio de una misión compartida. El Pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria está compuesto por las parroquias de San Ambrosio, Santa María de Alexandria y Santa María Anderson, junto con nuestras dos escuelas parroquiales y todos los demás ministerios que apoyan nuestras parroquias.

El Pastorado no es una fusión de parroquias ni escuelas. Para ilustrarlo, contamos con presupuestos separados para cada una de las tres parroquias y dos escuelas. Además, contamos con personal del Pastorado cuyo trabajo y ministerio no se centran en una sola parroquia, sino en todo el Pastorado.

Nuestra declaración de misión, desarrollada por nuestro Equipo de Liderazgo Pastoral y el Consejo Pastoral, declara: "Nosotros, el Pastorado Católico de Anderson-Alexandria, unidos en Jesucristo a través de su Palabra, los Sacramentos y la Eucaristía, estamos llamados a proclamar con alegría su Evangelio y servir con amor a su pueblo."

Resumimos esta declaración con estas palabras: «Proclamar con alegría, servir con amor».


También contamos con un logotipo para el Pastorado. Varios de ustedes enviaron ideas para el logotipo, y les estoy muy agradecido. Los colores del logotipo son azul (por la Santísima Virgen) y dorado (por San Ambrosio). Sobre las imágenes de tres iglesias y tres cruces, hay un arco. El arco no representa ningún objeto específico, sino que evoca el sol, la luna, la hostia eucarística, un arcoíris e incluso un abrazo. (Un participante expresó su preocupación por su parecido con un símbolo islámico). En lugar de definir el significado del arco, lo dejaremos muy ambiguo, ya que une las imágenes de las tres iglesias.

Aún nos quedan algunos detalles por pulir, por ejemplo, insertar la escritura correcta: "Pastorado Católico/Anderson-Alexandria/Catholic Pastorate." Despues, la incorporaremos a nuestro boletín, membrete, sitio web, etc.

Resurrection is our call to do what is right in this world. Please remember that neither our priests nor anyone else from our pastorate or diocese will ever email or text you a message requesting confidential and/or urgent financial assistance (such as buying gift cards or sending money through a payment app).

Even if Father's name is on the message and the email looks real (and it very well may, as the fraudsters are becoming more sophisticated every day), it is *not* a legitimate request. It is a SCAM created to con you out of as much of your hard-earned money as possible.

If you are ever in doubt, find a way to speak directly to the person—ideally, face to face—before you take any action. Don't become the next victim!

Recuerde que ni nuestros sacerdotes ni ningún otro miembro de nuestro pastordado ni diócesis le enviará jamás un correo electrónico o un mensaje de texto solicitando asistencia financiera confidencial y/o urgente (como la compra de tarjetas de regalo o el envío de dinero a través de una aplicación de pago).

Aunque el nombre del padre aparezca en el mensaje y el correo electrónico parezca real (y muy bien podría suceder así, ya que los estafadores son cada vez más sofisticados), *no* es una solicitud legítima. Es una ESTAFA creada para robarle la mayor parte posible del dinero que tanto le ha costado ganar.

Si usted tuviera duda, busque la manera de hablar directamente con la persona, idealmente cara a cara, antes de tomar cualquier medida. ¡No se convierta en la próxima víctima!

Are you a divorced Catholic thinking about getting an annulment and have no idea how to get started? Have you started the process but are feeling overwhelmed and or have questions?



your annulment pathway!



Since our VBS students have been getting an introduction to the sacred scriptures, it's time to ask ourselves:

Why Read the Bible?

The Bible is the world's best bestseller. Not only is it God's inspired Word, it's a great work of literature. It's a collection of books composed over many centuries, with many literary forms, including history, historical novels, parables, allegories, and poems. It tells a tale that stretches back to the creation of the world and forward to the end of time. It speaks of faith, hope, love and forgiveness, describes every human emotion, depicts the heights and depths of human courage and depravity, and above all God's unconditional love for humanity and his salvific plan.

There are numerous reasons to read the Scriptures.

- It is part of the inspired Word of God. The Old and New Testament together form the inspired Word of God in human language. The Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation from the Second Vatican Council states clearly that “the books of Scripture must be acknowledged as teaching solidly, faithfully and without error that truth which God wanted put into the sacred writings for the sake of our salvation.”
- It chronicles for us God’s loving plan of salvation for all.
- Because the New Testament is hidden in the Old, and the Old is made manifest in the New.
- Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ.
- Scripture is a deep font for the Church’s worship and prayer life. Since the Second Vatican Council, the Church has provided for an expanded use of Sacred Scriptures in the Liturgy of the Word at Mass, in the celebration of the other sacraments and the devotional life of the Church, and in its urgings to the laity to celebrate Morning and Evening Prayer which incorporates recitation of the Psalms.
- It continues to instruct the faithful and call them to faithfulness in their covenant with God.


Ya que nuestros alumnos de la Escuela Bíblica de Vacaciones han recibido una introducción a las sagradas escrituras, es hora de que nos preguntemos:

¿Por qué leer la Biblia?



La Biblia es el libro más vendido del mundo. No solo es la Palabra inspirada de Dios, sino también una gran obra literaria. Es una colección de libros compuestos a lo largo de siglos, con diversas formas literarias, incluyendo historia, novelas históricas, parábolas, alegorías y poemas. Narra una historia que se remonta a la creación del mundo y llega hasta el fin de los tiempos. Habla de fe, esperanza, amor y perdón, describe cada emoción humana, describe las alturas y las profundidades de la valentía y la depravación humanas, y sobre todo, el amor incondicional de Dios por la humanidad y su plan salvífico.

Hay numerosas razones para leer las Escrituras.



- Forma parte de la Palabra inspirada de Dios. El Antiguo y el Nuevo Testamento juntos forman la Palabra inspirada de Dios en lenguaje humano. La Constitución Dogmática sobre la Divina Revelación del Concilio Vaticano II establece claramente que “los libros de la Escritura deben ser reconocidos como la enseñanza sólida, fiel e infalible de la verdad que Dios quiso plasmar en las Sagradas Escrituras para nuestra salvación.”
- Nos narra el amoroso plan de salvación de Dios para todos.
- Porque el Nuevo Testamento está oculto en el Antiguo, y el Antiguo se manifiesta en el Nuevo.
- Desconocer las Escrituras es desconocer a Cristo.
- La Escritura es una fuente profunda para el culto y la vida de oración de la Iglesia. Desde el Concilio Vaticano II, la Iglesia ha propiciado un uso más amplio de las Sagradas Escrituras en la Liturgia de la Palabra en la Misa, en la celebración de los demás sacramentos y en la vida devocional de la Iglesia, y en sus exhortaciones a los laicos a celebrar las Oraciones de la mañana y de la tarde, que incorporan la recitación de los Salmos.
- Sigue instruyendo a los fieles y llamándolos a la fidelidad en su alianza con Dios.

Potential for transformation and growth


- The county fair can be a place where individuals learn valuable lessons.
