
Sacramental Prep Policy:

In compliance with Archdiocesan policy and recommendations for the preparation and reception of the Sacraments, St. Patrick requires that any candidate receiving the Sacraments of Confirmation, First Reconciliation and First Eucharist must be actively involved in age appropriate Religious Education for a minimum of 1 year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacraments. The candidates must have regular attendance in our programs. Additionally, it will be expected that each candidate will continue to be involved in age appropriate classes and regularly attend weekend Mass during the period of Preparation for the Sacrament.

Marriage Policy

Please contact the Pastor at least **six months** prior to the wedding to ensure adequate time for these preparations.

Message from the Pastor

INSTALLATION MASS FOR FR. ARTURO

Sunday, August 6th at 11:00 AM

IT IS OFFICIAL...

Effective July 1st I will officially be the Pastor of Saint Patrick Parish in Canby, Oregon for a period of six years. By this appointment I will assume the duties and responsibilities and enjoy the rights and privileges accorded to pastors, in accordance with the prescriptions of the Code of Canon Law (Cf. Canons 519, 521, 522, 527-535). I have also been granted General Archdiocesan Faculties for pastors in order to exercise priestly ministries. We will have an **Installation Mass on SUNDAY, AUGUST 6th at 11:00 AM** presided by a priest who will represent Archbishop Sample and who will receive my Profession of Faith and Oath of Office. There will be a reception following the Mass. I'm inviting everyone to be part of this ceremony and asking for prayers and support in this new assignment given to me by the Catholic Church through Archbishop Sample and the Archdiocese of Portland.

WERE YOU NOT OUR PASTOR BEFORE?

It is a question you probably have in mind. When a parish is "vacant", meaning that the pastor has retired, been transferred to another assignment, or is incapable of exercising his duties as a pastor, the Archbishop must appoint, as soon as possible, a parochial administrator.

In general, an administrator has the same duties and scope of authority as a pastor, however, these may be limited by the Archbishop. The Archbishop in time may decide to appoint the administrator as the pastor. The Code of Canon Law stipulates, "For the office of pastor to be conferred on someone, it is necessary that his suitability be clearly evident by means of some method determined by the diocesan bishop, even by means of an examination" (No. 521.3).

Therefore, in deciding the appointment of a pastor to a vacant parish, the Archbishop should make a judgement based on his knowledge of the priest's character and abilities, and on the advice of other priests and laity (No. 524). As such, the Archbishop may obtain this knowledge and advice during a priest's time as administrator of a parish. *One interesting note here:* The Archbishop may transfer or remove an administrator at any time; however, a pastor does have certain rights protected by canon law.

FROM PAROCHIAL ADMINISTRATOR TO PASTOR.

Since I was ordained on June 9th, 2012, I have served as Parochial Vicar at St. Luke in Woodburn and Sacred Heart in Medford. Then, on July 1, 2014, I was appointed Parochial Administrator at the parish of St. Patrick. I have been here for 3 years, and since I have been ordained for more than 5 years, it is necessary that a pastor be provided for our church for the continuance of worship and the good of souls. Archbishop Sample by appointment of the Apostolic See having been assured of my good character, knowledge, mature age and other necessary qualifications, as required by the prescriptions of Canon Law and Archdiocesan policies committed to me. I'm thankful to God and all of you for this commitment entrusted to me, and I want to ask you to keep me in your prayers to exercise this ministry faithfully.
