In this Sunday's "Lesson", or First Reading, we have the passage from Acts of the Apostles (Acts 8:14-17) that describes the first celebration of the Sacrament that the Roman Catholic Church would eventually name "Confirmation". The Apostles Peter and John went down from Jerusalem to Samaria to visit a new Christian community there. The two Apostles "prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Spirit, for it had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus" Baptism, all by itself, is not enough. In some way it needs to be completed. Therefore the Apostles "laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit". The Baptism of those new Christians was confirmed by the apostolic laying on of hands.

The Apostolic Ministry is carried on through the Church's Bishops, and through the Priests ordained to be coworkers with the Bishops. The apostolic laying of hands in Confirmation is part of that ongoing apostolic ministry. In the Roman Catholic Church, the Bishop is the ordinary minister of Confirmation, but not the only one. When adults are baptized, the priest who baptizes them is always delegated to confirm them. In other extraordinary situations, the Bishops may delegate a priest to celebrate Confirmation. This year the Fremont County Confirmation Liturgy, scheduled for May 10, had to be cancelled. While the Bishop intends to make a Confirmation circuit in the Fall, I have judged it advisable, given the uncertainty of the times, to ask for delegation to confirm Holy Rosary's "Confirmation Class" of 2020. When I have received delegation, or when the Bishop has set a date, I will inform the Parish of the date for Confirmation.


Using the term "Confirmation Class" may be a little unwise on my part, since it would be terribly unfortunate if people thought of Confirmation as some sort of religious graduation ceremony. It is the completion of a Christian's Baptism, conferring those gifts of the Holy Spirit that the Lord intends to give to that person. For those gifts to be "unwrapped", so to speak, the Christian must continue in religious formation, learning to recognize and use the gifts of the Spirit. Confirmation gives the potential to become great "athletes of Christ" (an image used by several Church Fathers). For that potential to be realized, a great deal of training, exercise and coaching is required.

#### SEVEN ESSENTIALS ABOUT CONFIRMATION

- 1. It is instituted in Acts 8: 14-17.
- 2. It completes the Grace of Baptism, giving the gifts of the Holy Spirit that make a Christian truly an adopted son or daughter of God, that enable the Christian little by little to have the mind of Christ, and that make a Christian an active and effective member of the Church. Confirmation gives the potential to become a Saint.
- 3. Confirmation imprints a permanent mark on the soul, and can only be received once. In the Roman Catholic Church, Confirmation is usually given shortly after a Christian has reached the age of reason (about seven years old; 12 years old might be called "shortly"
- 4. In the Roman Catholic Church, Confirmation is usually given shortly after a Christian has reached the age of reason (about seven years old; 12 years old might be called "shortly after", but 16 is stretching that too far; the Diocese moved away from high school age Confirmation because it had to)
- 5. In the Roman Catholic Church Confirmation is usually given by the Bishop (exceptions are made see above)
- 6. To receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Roman Catholic Church, a Christian must have reached the age of reason, professed the Catholic Faith, be free of unconfessed and unabsolved grave sin, desire to receive the Sacrament, and be willing to live as a disciple of Jesus Christ.
- 7. The essential rite of Confirmation in the Roman Catholic Church today is the apostolic laying on of hands, and then the anointing of the forehead with the Sacred Chrism, accompanied by the words "Be Sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit" (Accipe Signaculum Doni Spiritus Sancti"



Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is in the church on Sundays from 11:30-12:30 p.m.
