Archdiocese of Washington Coronavirus Notice

In the interest of public health and safety, local governments have issued restrictions on certain activities in response to the coronavirus. Most recently the State of Maryland has ordered that no public gatherings in excess of 250 people may be held until further notice. As a result of this order, Archbishop Gregory has indicated that ALL Masses open to the public, in ALL archdiocesan parishes, missions, and campus ministries will not be celebrated starting this Saturday, March 14th until further notice. Weddings and funerals will proceed but attendance should be limited to immediate family.

Archbishop Gregory has also issued a dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass during this time to all parishioners of the Archdiocese of Washington.

In light of this directive, No Mass will be celebrated at St. Mary Star of the Sea until further notice. All scheduled funerals and wedding will proceed as scheduled.
