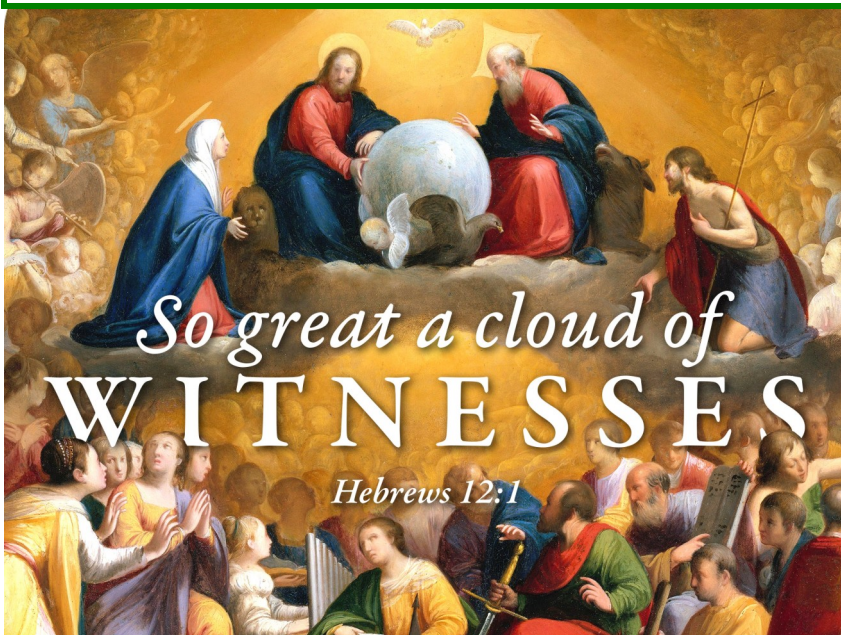
### Funeral Rite
