### **Behind the Mass Readings**

#### **First Reading: Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29**

A wise teacher who lived 200 years before Christ, Sirach ran a school for young people in Jerusalem. In today's passage, he educates his students on proper conduct with a string of wise sayings.

#### **Second Reading: Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24**

In today's reading, the Hebrews learn about two different covenants. The author explains that, while the covenant at Mount Sinai was forged in fire and darkness, the new covenant at Mount Zion — another name for Jerusalem, was forged by Jesus in love and compassion.
