Behind the Mass Readings

First Reading: Mal 3:19-20

The Book of Malachi was written after the Babylonian exile to assuage the troubled Jewish community's doubts that God would act on their behalf. Malachi responds to those skeptics in today's passage.

Second Reading: 2 Thess 3:7-12

St. Paul wrote the second letter to the Thessalonians as a way of addressing the early Christian's concerns about the Parousia. While some were excited about the prospect of Christ's Second Coming, others believed that it gave them permission to be idle in their faith.


