
### Funeral Rite

## Behind the Mass Readings

### **First Reading: Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7**

The prophet in this passage from the Book of Isaiah spoke to the people exiled in Babylon. He tells them four different times that a mysterious servant will deliver them and make them great — this prophet was Jesus.

### **Second Reading: Acts 10:34-38**

The apostle Peter was originally unsure that the Gentiles were worthy of hearing the Gospel. The Holy Spirit then summoned him to preach among the Gentiles, specifically a man in the army — Cornelius — and the profound experience changed his mind.
