

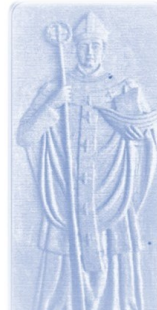

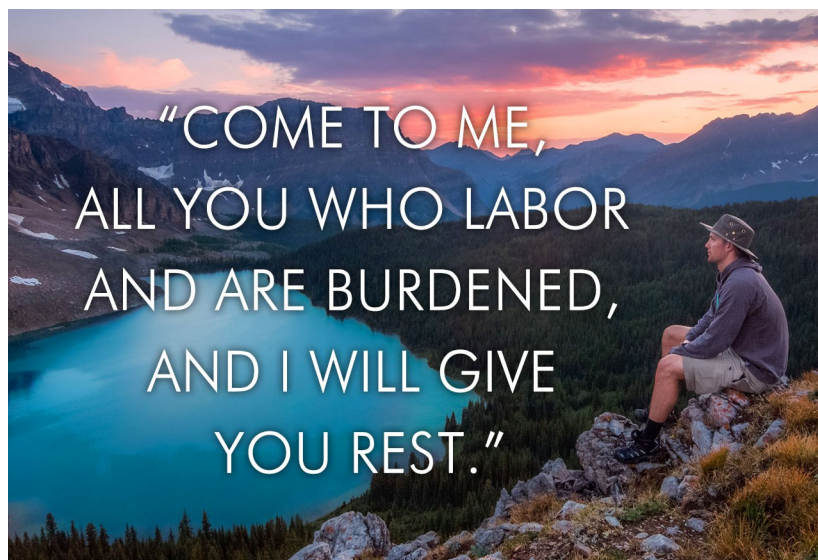
Funeral Rite
