Dear Parents,

Beginning 09/10/2020, St. John Vianney began using an integrated version of the FACTS Tuition Management and FACTS SIS systems. As of this date you will access your FACTS account via FACTS Family Portal. You will find the Family Portal link on the school website or by following the steps below:

FACTS Family Portal Login Instructions

- Please go to the website <https://www.factsmgt.com/>
- Click on "Parent Log In" at the top, then "FACTS Family Portal."
- If you already have an account, enter username and password and click Login.
- **Create New Family Portal Account if you have not set this up yet**
- Enter the email address that received this email, and our District Code

Our District Code is **SJV-WI**

- You will receive an email from SIS Customer Support containing a link that will allow you to create your username and password. For security purposes the link will remain active for six hours.
- Please click on the link. A **Change/Create Password** screen will open. You may use the default username provided, or create a new username. Then type in your desired password into the Password field and Confirm Field
- Click on the **Save Username and/or Password** button
- Close the window.
- Log into **FACTS Family Portal** as instructed above

ORDERING HOT LUNCH THROUGH FACTS/RENWEB

You must already have access to FACTS/RENWEB and your payment plan set up to order.

*****PLEASE READ EACH STEP CAREFULLY*****

DIRECTIONS USING THE PARENTS WEB SITE ON THE INTERNET:

1. Go to factsmgt.com.
2. Select **PARENT LOG IN**.
3. Select **FACTS FAMILY ONLINE (ParentsWeb)**.
4. Sign in.
5. Select **STUDENT INFORMATION** from the menu on the left.
6. Select **LUNCH** from the menu under Student Information and a calendar will pop up. Select the start date for the menu (The menu for that week will show, if you chose for the month time frame, the entire month will show).
 - a. If you would like to see more than 1 week of the menu on the screen, choose **TIME FRAME: MONTH**
7. Select the start date for the menu. (The menu for that week will show, if you chose for the month time frame, the entire month will show.)
8. When you're ready to order lunch, select **CREATE WEB ORDER**.
9. Select which student you would like to order for first. A list of dates will appear. Click on the date you would like to order hot lunch and a drop-down option will appear. Select the meal you would like to order. If you want doubles, please only select the Double Order for Main Entrée selection. You need to repeat this process for each day you want to order.
10. When you're done selecting for the month, go to the bottom of the page and select **SUBMIT ORDER**.
11. Your order should appear with a total amount of money.

PRINTING MENU: To print a copy of the menu, you can go into ParentsWeb and select PRINT WEEK OR PRINT MONTH.

Family Puzzle Pieces

Each family will be given a puzzle piece to decorate to represent their family. The puzzle pieces will be displayed in the commons with a family Lent quote.

Saint Buddy Activity - Apr 11, 2022

Kids will be encouraged to dress up as a saint or as something that patron saint represents (ex. Dress as a farmer for St. Isidore). Classes will schedule a time to get together with their buddy class for each kid to tell their buddy about their saint.

Classroom Packet of Activities

Service Project

We are going to offer support and encouragement to our local healthcare workers by putting together snack baskets. 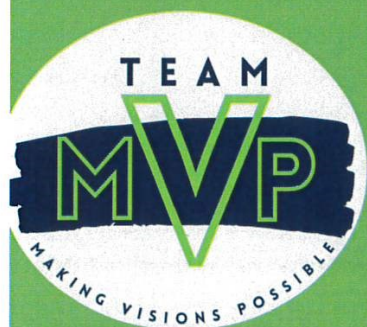
