Next year we will host a visiting team who will audit our curriculum, environment, policies and procedures, facilities, long-range planning, and staffing. This is a huge undertaking that cannot be done without your help. This weekend we will be asking all parents, students, parishioners, and staff to complete surveys. #### **WRISA Accreditation Process**

A school community reviews the WRISA Pre-Accreditation Criteria and submits an <u>application for candidate status</u> to the WRISA or jurisdictional office. A candidate school has three years to complete the candidacy required activities and present its documentation to WRISA for membership. Application fees are \$200.

- 1. A school community takes an in-depth look at itself through a WRISA approved self study. This comprehensive study will require a minimum of one year to complete.
- 2. A visiting team of professional educators visits the schools and conducts a comprehensive review of the school, validates the finding of the self study, and determines if the school is in substantial compliance with the WRISA standard quality indicators.
- 3. The visiting team submits a report of its findings to the school and jurisdiction. The school then creates a visionary plan for the future that merges the recommendations of the school with those from the visiting team. This plan becomes the centerpiece of the review process for the remainder of the seven year, self study and visiting team cycle.
- 4. The school submits all review documentation and the long range plan to the jurisdiction's office. These documents are reviewed by the WRISA Board of Directors at the September meeting of the Board of Directors. Schools are notified of their status prior to October 31st.
- 5. Accreditation is granted on an annual basis. Annual Report information is conveyed to schools prior to September 1st each year. A school reports its compliance with the WRISA standards and its progress on its long range plan goals. The school submits its completed Annual Report to its jurisdictional representative prior to September 30th. A school not belonging to a jurisdiction, sends its report directly to the representative for non-jurisdiction schools.
- 6. Each school must conduct a self-study, host a visiting team, and submit a new Visiting Team Report and Long Range Plan every seven years.

- Click on the Save Username and/or Password button
- Close the window.

#### DIRECTIONS USING THE PARENTS WEB SITE ON THE INTERNET:

- 1. Go to factsmgt.com.
- 2. Select PARENT LOG IN.
- 3. Select FACTS FAMILY ONLINE (ParentsWeb).
- 4. Sign in.
- 5. Select **STUDENT INFORMATION** from the menu on the left.
- 6. Select **LUNCH** from the menu under Student Information and a calendar will pop up. Select the start date for the menu (The menu for that week will show, if you chose for the month time frame, the entire month will show).
  - a. If you would like to see more than 1 week of the menu on the screen, choose **TIME FRAME: MONTH**
- 7. Select the start date for the menu. (The menu for that week will show, if you chose for the month time frame, the entire month will show.)
- 8. When you're ready to order lunch, select **CREATE WEB ORDER**.
- 9. Select which student you would like to order for first. A list of dates will appear. Click on the date you would like to order hot lunch and a drop-down option will appear. Select the meal you would like to order. If you want doubles, please only select the Double Order for Main Entrée selection. You need to repeat this process for each day you want to order.
- 10. When you're done selecting for the month, go to the bottom of the page and select **SUBMIT ORDER**.
- 11. Your order should appear with a total amount of money.

This report includes tuition, online enrollment fee, before care, after care, etc.

- 1. Log into your FACTS Family Portal. Click the Financial tab on the left side and then click Financial Home on the Financial Links tab on the top right or you can log into your account at online.factsmgt.com
- 2. Next to Payment Plan & Billing click the blue text View Details
- 3. On the new page underneath your name and customer number click the blue tab View Payment Summary
- 4. You should see a summary of the accounts for 2021-22 and 2022-23

#### Reminders:

Please remember to email the school office or call and leave a message **by 8:00 am** if your child will be absent due to illness or arriving late due to an appointment. All students leaving the building after the start of school for an appointment need to have an email, call, or written permission for excusal from a parent/guardian before the appointment. This must be communicated to the teacher and the school office **by 8:00 AM**.


For families with students in grades K-8, the \$3,000 annual Scrip purchase requirement for the 2022-23 school year must be met by January 31, 2023.

#### As stated in the 2022-23 tuition contract:

- All school families are expected to purchase a minimum of \$3,000 from the Scrip program by January 31, 2023, with students in grades five-year-old kindergarten through 8th grade.
- This amount is not pro-rated based on the enrollment date.
- A \$300 fee will be required for those who do not meet the minimum and will be collected through FACTS in February 2023.

**Hot Lunch** can now be ordered through the end of the school year.

- You can go in anytime and unselect or alter any of the lunches before that month's closing. To double-check, any lunches that have been ordered will be in blue in the FACTS family portal.
- On the red left side, select the student drop-down menu and then select lunch. The lunch calendar should then appear.
- From the top, you can select and check the menu by day, week, or month.
- Once an item is removed/unselected it will no longer light up blue.

- Choose your Home Parish + City based on where your family is registered and regularly attends.
- Create missionary profiles for any teens AND adults in your family that you
  intend on registering. (Creating a family account is not enough to enroll an
  adult for LBH.) We would love for you to add photos into each family
  member's Missionary Profile!
- After creating your family account with ALL missionaries you intend on registering, you will be able to begin enrolling individual missionaries in your family for their weeks.
- If your ideal choice is full, sign up for a week to be added to a waiting list.
- You can be on multiple waiting lists, but they should be weeks you could
  actually attend. As space allows, teens on Waiting Lists could be released
  at any point, but most releases will happen in late spring.
- Though it may be a slight inconvenience, you have to check out each missionary ONE AT A TIME!

## Before starting online registration, make sure to have the following ready...

- Insurance Card with company info, member and group numbers, etc.
- Prescription Medicine Information, incl. names and dosages
- Phone Numbers for Two Emergency Contacts
- Credit Card, if you prefer to pay using one

If registering as a Lead Missionary, make sure to also have...

- Driver's License
- Vehicle Registration Information
- Vehicle Insurance Information

If you need financial aid, contact your Parish Leader BEFORE beginning registration, as you'll need to enter a code at checkout. (If you're a Lost Sheep who needs financial aid e-mail lbh@madisondiocese.org, and we will help you out!)
