



St. Ignatius of Loyola (1491 – 1556) was a Spanish theologian and mystic. With Peter Faber and Francis Xavier he founded the Society of Jesus (Jesuits), which is a religious order dedicated to teaching and missionary work. St.


Ignatius was the first Superior General of the Jesuits. Before his religious conversion, he was a soldier and a diplomat. He was canonized March 12, 1622; his feast day is July 31.
