Saint of the Week: St. Josephine Bakhita

Josephine Bakhita was born around 1869 in Sudan in the village of Olgossa, Sudan. When Bakhita was seven or eight, Arab slave traders kidnapped her and sold her into slavery. She was sold multiple times. Bakhita lived and worked in various locations in Africa until an Italian consul bought her and moved his family back to Schio, Italy. Bakhita became a nanny for her new family, and she and her young charge lived at the convent run by the Canossian Sisters in Venice.

When her owners wanted to move back to Africa, Bakhita wished to stay in Italy. The Canossian Sisters went to court on her behalf and helped her obtain her freedom. Bakhita remained in Italy and lived as a free woman. She converted to Christianity and was baptized and



confirmed in 1890. She became a Canossian nun in December 1896 and remained at their convent for another 42 years. In 2000, she was declared a saint, the first Black woman to receive the honor in the modern era and the patron saint of human trafficking.
