This Week: St. Joseph the Protector

God the Father chose St. Joseph to be the foster father and guardian of Jesus. He was the protector and provider for the Holy Family, for Jesus as a child and as He grew into manhood. One



example that portrays the difficulties and trials that Joseph underwent to guard Jesus and Mary was their long journey fleeing to Egypt to escape death by Herod's soldiers. They came to a land that was totally unfamiliar to them, seeking to earn a living in a country in which they did not speak the language.

Since we belong to Christ and His Church through baptism, and Jesus was under the protection of St. Joseph, it follows fittingly that St. Joseph is our guardian, too. His role is to watch over us and protect us, and, therefore, St. Joseph can rightfully be called the "guardian of the redeemed.
