Sign of Peace and Communion from the Cup During Flu Season

– With the flu season upon us, it would be helpful for each of us to take precautions in order to reduce the risk of passing on the flu. If you are sick, the obligation to attend Mass is lifted. If you are not feeling well, but choose to participate in the Sunday liturgy please refrain from drinking from the cup to protect others from illness. Additionally, offering the Sign of Peace may be done in the form of a nod of the head and simply saying, "Peace be with you". Washing hands thoroughly before attending Mass is another very helpful precaution. It is important that children also follow these same precautions.

Hospitalized Parishioners – the local hospitals want to support you spiritually when you are admitted into the hospital. Below are some reminders to help make this process easier.

1. Upon admission, let them know you are Catholic.
2. Have a family member notify the Parish Office at 941-3661 ext 10, if you are in the hospital (hospitals no longer make the call).
3. If you are scheduled for surgery, call the parish Office at 941-3661 ext. 10, for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick BEFORE you go to the hospital. Ask your nurse to call a hospital chaplain to offer spiritual care, help answer questions, provide communion and help contact your parish.

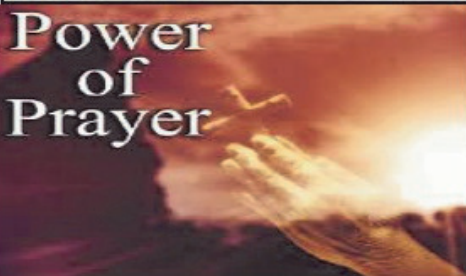
GOSPEL REFLECTION

GOSPEL: Luke 6: 17, 20-26

Today, we review again the "beatitudes" and the "misfortunes" Fortunate are you... when people hate you because of the Son of Man; But, ...alas for you who laugh now for you will mourn and weep». Fidelity to Christ and to his Gospel may make us to be rejected, insulted by the media, hated, as Christ was hated by those who crucified him. Some may think this is due to lack of faith, but maybe, after all, is just lack of reasoning. Indeed, it seems our world refuses to think or be free. We are immersed in a lust for pleasure and riches; immersed in consumables; blinded by the libertarian indoctrination full of vain and empty words, which darken our personal standards and values and scorns the Church's and Christ's teachings, which is the only line of thinking that, right now, truly goes up stream. But, in spite of this, the Lord-Jesus still encourages us:

«Fortunate are you who weep now, for you will laugh. Fortunate are you when people hate you, when they reject you and insult you and number you among criminals, because of the Son of Man. Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, for a great reward is kept for you in heaven» (Lk 6:22-23).

John Paul II The, in the encyclical *Fides et Ratio*, wrote: «Faith impels reason to leave its isolation and to advocate gladly for what is beautiful, good and true». The Christian experience, in its saints, show us the truth of the Gospel and of these words from Holy Father. Confronting a world that indulges in vice and selfishness as the only source of happiness, Jesus shows us another way: the happiness of the Kingdom of God, which our world finds so difficult to assume to the point of hating and rejecting it. Christians, in the midst of all temptations that this "easy life" offers, know the only way is the love Christ has shown for us in the Cross, the way of fidelity to the Father. We know that difficulties should not discourage us. If we truly seek our Lord, «Rejoice in that day and leap for joy» (cf. Lk 6:23). *Evangelii.net*

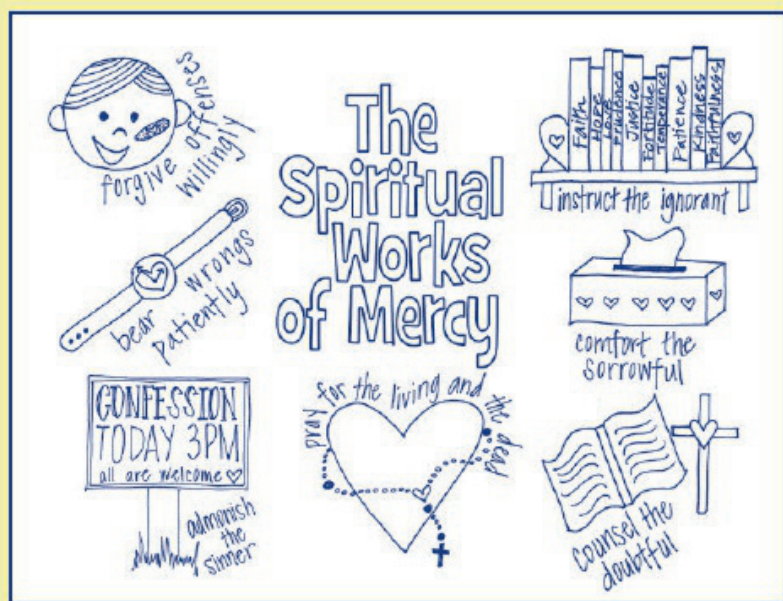

WAYS TO PRACTICE THE SPIRITUAL WORKS OF MERCY

- **Forgive offenses willingly:** When you are angry with your brother or sister for treating you badly, forgive them and remember that Jesus forgives us for the wrong we do.
- **Bear wrongs patiently:** When things seem to not go our way, be patient and realize that God is always with you and that although it may be hard, we can do all things for love of Jesus!
- **Admonish the sinner:** we can be a good example to others by being the first to apologize, and by making sure that we go to confession frequently so that we are always at peace with God our Father.
- **Pray for the living and the dead:** Make a prayer rock, and put it on your pillow each morning when you get up. As you go to sleep, it will remind you to pray, and if you then place it by your slippers, you will also remember to pray in the morning!
- **Comfort the sorrowful:** If you see someone is sad, give them a smile. Take time to say hello, and if possible do something nice for them.
- **Counsel the Doubtful:** see below!
- **Instruct the Ignorant:** Keep Jesus in your heart. Remember that He asked us to love one another as he loved us. By living this even at a young age, you are a good example to all the people in your life.

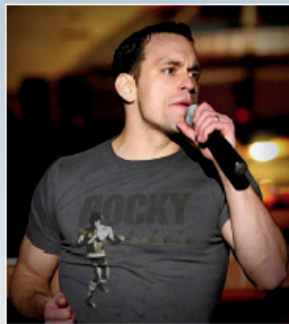
